### **Arrival and Reception**

### **Approach Route**

- The reception building is on the left hand side when you enter the site
- The gate from the road is left open at all times during the day
- The ground is level in this area with hard surfaced paths linking facilities.

### **Parking**

- There is only one parking space, outside of the storage area
- There are no late night arrival bays

#### **Entrance into Reception**

- There is a 30mm step at the reception door
- The Entrance door is 700mm wide with a 30mm threshold
- The entrance door is not power assisted, and opens outwards
- A call bell is available to summon assistance, this is 1300mm above ground level





### Reception

- There is approximately 1200mm x 2450mm turning space, clear of the desk and furniture
- The reception desk is set 930mm above the floor with no dropped section
- The desk is not fitted with a hearing loop



### Getting around the Site

- The site is set on a slight slope, but still relatively level throughout
- Pedestrians share vehicles routes which are well maintained tarmac without any speed bumps

#### **Pitches**

- There are 16 pitches on site, all of which are hardstanding
- Roll out mats are not provided
- There are no designated accessible pitches, however pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.
- All pitches are hardstanding
- All pitches are within 40 metres of the reception building and information room



### **Toilets and Changing Facilities**

• There are no toilet or changing facilities on site

### **Other Facilities**

There are no dishwashing or laundry facilities on site

### Information Room - Close to Reception

- The information room is directly next to the reception
- There is a 100mm step into the door
- The double door opens to 500mm wide either side over a 50mm threshold and open outwards
- The room's dimensions are 1650mm x 1400mm
- Information is displayed on racks between 40mm and 1200mm high



#### **Service Points**

- There is one Service Point on the site, located towards the north of the site
- The service point is accessed via a 1000mm wide gravel path, with a 70mm step up

- The paths around the Service Point can be as narrow as 600mm wide
- The water taps are at a maximum of 800mm high, with cross head taps
- There is no Motorhome Service Point on site







### **Chemical Toilet Emptying Point**

- There is one Chemical Toilet Emptying Point on site, located to the north of the site
- The access to the Chemical Emptying Point is via a 600mm path which has both paving and gravel
- The tap is 850mm high







### Dog Walk

- There is a dog walk available next to the entrance of the site, this is within a wooded area
- There is a wide double gate to access
