Arrival and Reception

Approach Route

- To access the site there is a narrow lane with no passing places, this means it is important that guests arrive and depart at the times instructed
- Access onto the site is via a tarmac driveway
- The reception building is on the left hand side when you enter the site
- The gate from the road is left open at all times but access into the site is controlled via a vehicle barrier controlled by card access.
- The ground is level in this area with hard surfaced paths linking facilities.

Parking

- A new arrival bay is set within a few metres of the Reception building.
- There is a visitor parking area for 3 vehicles to the left of the Reception building.
 This area has a gravel ground, with no marked bays or disabled bays
- There is no Late Night Arrival area on site

Entrance into Reception

- There is a concrete ramp into the reception building, this ramp has handrails on both sides and is 1100mm wide, this is accessed from the visitor parking area
- There is also a stepped entrance to the building, this has two steps with handrails on both sides
- The Entrance door is 1000mm wide with a level threshold
- The entrance door is not power assisted, and opens inwards, but can be very hard to open
- A call bell is available to summon assistance, this is 1100mm above ground level

Reception

- There is approximately 2000mm x 2700mm turning space, clear of the desk and furniture
- The reception desk is set 900mm above the floor with a dropped lift up section at 600mm high
- The desk is not fitted with a hearing loop





Getting around the Site

- The site is generally set relatively level throughout
- Pedestrians share vehicles routes which are well maintained tarmac with no speed bumps

Pitches

- There are 68 pitches on site, 46 of which are hardstanding
- Roll out mats are not provided
- There are no designated accessible pitches, however pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.
- There are 2 hardstanding pitches adjacent to the toilet block that are recommended for people with accessibility needs
- There are 10 hardstanding and 4 grass pitches within 50 metres of the toilet block

Toilets and Changing Facilities

Accessible Toilets and Bathing Facilities – Toilet Block

- A combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is located in the Toilet Block which is opposite reception, close to the entrance of the site.
- The Accessible Toilet and Shower is at the end of the toilet block and can be accessed by a 4 metre ramp with a handrail on one side, which is 1100mm wide
- The door is 900mm wide, over a level threshold and opens inwards
- The cubicle door is secured by RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's dimensions are 2300 x 1800mm and there is a further recessed shower alcove which dimensions are 1200 x 1300mm
- The WC pan is left hand transfer.
- The shower seat is right hand transfer
- The toilet seat is 480mm, and the shower seat is 480mm above the floor level

- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 2300mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The shower seat and WC Pan are fitted with grab rails to assist transfer
- Shower controls are 1200mm high



- The shower head is fitted on a sliding rail, which is a minimum of 1400mm above floor level
- The basin taps and shower controls are fitted with levers





Standard Toilets and Washrooms

- There is one toilet and shower block, which is opposite reception and close to the entrance of the site
- There is a 2.5 metre path to the adjacent pitches on a slight slope
- There is no parking at the toilet block
- There is a 1200mm wide path around the toilet block, which does incorporate a set of steps with no handrails
- The male toilets are at the front of the block
- The female toilets are at the back of the block
- The entrance doors to the male and female toilets have a step into each of them, the doors are opened with a key which can be borrowed from reception. The key hole is at 1400mm high
- The female area has 6 WC Cubicles, 4 Shower Cubicles and 5 Privacy Washbasin Cubicles
- The male area has 4 WC Cubicles, 4 Shower Cubicles, 3 Urinals and 6 Privacy Washbasin Cubicles
- Both male and female areas have a modified WC cubicle, privacy washbasin cubicle and shower cubicle with grab rails to assist mobility



• Taps in each block incorporate lever controls



Baby and Toddler Room

- The baby and toddler room is accessed by a 4 metre long ramp, with handrails on both sides which is 1000mm wide
- There is also an alternative stepped approach to the Baby and Toddler Room
- The door is outward opening, 800mm wide and over a level threshold
- The rooms dimensions are 2700mm x 1100mm
- A key can be borrowed from reception, and the key hole is 1000mm high.
- There is a lowered WC at 400mm and a regular wash basin
- There is a half sized bathtub with a shower over the top, with twist turn taps
- There is a wall mounted, drop down baby changing table at 900mm high





Other Facilities

Dishwashing – Toilet Block

- The dishwashing room is accessed by a 4 metre long ramp, with handrails on both sides which is 1000mm wide
- There is also an alternative stepped approach into the dishwashing room
- Double doors open outwards to 500mm wide on either side, when they open outward they leave a 750mm gap on the path
- There are 4 sinks at 890mm high with 860mm kneespace below
- There is only 670mm clear space in front of the counter
- Lever taps are available



Laundry - Toilet Block

- The laundry room is accessed by a 4 metre long ramp, with handrails on both sides which is 1000mm wide
- There is also an alternative stepped approach into the laundry room
- The door is 750mm wide over a level threshold
- There is 1700mm x 3500mm circulation space
- There is one front loading washing machine and one front loading tumble dryer

- There are 3 sinks at 890mm high, in a counter with very limited knee space
- Taps are thumb turn taps

Information Room – Opposite Reception

- The information room is in a shed opposite the reception
- The door opens to 700mm wide, and opens outwards
- There is a 90mm step in to the room and a 40mm step out of the room
- There is 1200mm x 2000mm circulation space
- The information is displayed on a shelf at 900mm high





Service Points

• There are two Service Points around the site, one opposite the toilet block and one at the other end of the site



- Both of the service points are on concrete settings, with level access from the adjacent roads
- The paths around the Service Points can be as narrow as 600mm wide
- The water taps are at a maximum of 750mm high, with cross head taps
- Chemical Waste Points can be found here too, these have limited manoeuvring space



Motorhome Waste Point

- There is one Motorhome Waste Point on site, located to the side of the toilet block
- The taps are 1100mm high
