

### OTHER ROUTES IN THE AREA

National Route 26 - The Strawberry Line is close by, between Yatton and Cheddar on a disused railway line.



#### **DIRECTIONS**

- 1 Head north from The Club Site along Red Road.
- 2 Branch right on to Wick Road passing Wick Farm.
- 3 Turn right just before the railway bridge along Wick Lane, crossing the railway along the way.
- 4 Turn left along the B3140 where you can clearly see Brent Knoll fort.
- 5 Another left turn brings you on to West Road.
- 6 A good place to stop for a picnic is in Lympsham, beside the school or church. Turn left heading out of Lympsham.
- 7 Turn left to railway crossing, and follow the beginning of the route in reverse back to the Club Site.

#### DON'T MISS

**66** Friendly wardens - both our girls learned to recognised by one of the wardens.
