



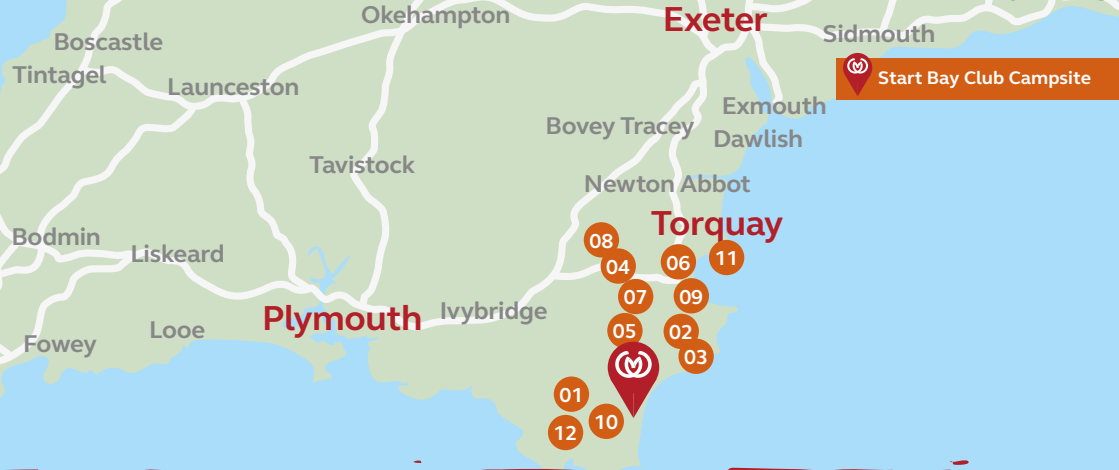

## Walk

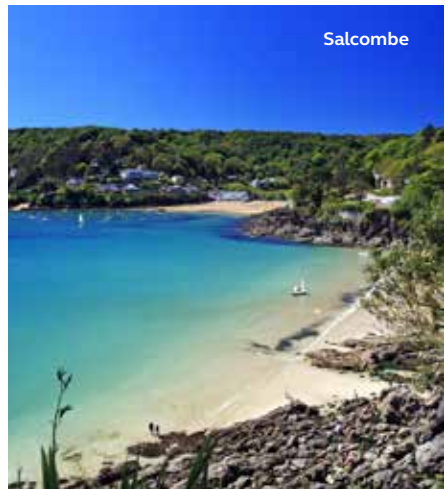
- 8 Totnes and Dartington**  
A waymarked route linking Totnes and Dartington.
- 9 Greenway Walk**  
Experience breathtaking views of the spectacular Tor Bay.

## Explore

- 11 Torquay**  
This traditional British seaside resort is a vibrant town set in the heart of the English Riviera. It is famous for its sandy beaches, family attractions and genteel Victorian appearance.
- 12 Salcombe**  
Salcombe is one of the prettiest towns in South Devon. It is known for its outstanding coastal views and surrounding countryside, as well as a centre for sailing.

- 10 Okehampton to Plymouth**  
The nearest National Cycle Network route is Route 2.

## Visitor's top tips

**||** Slapton Sands, a lovely dog-friendly beach, is only a 20 minute walk away.

Take the footpath from site to two local pubs, all within a 15 minute walk.

Take the bus to Dartmouth, make sure you sit on the top deck to see the views!

Walk the South West coast path – one of the world's best long distance walks.

Agatha Christie's holiday home, Greenway, is well worth a visit by boat from Dartmouth.

Mill Bay is tricky to get to but a fun day out with the boat to Salcombe.

The farm shop next door was great for BBQ supplies and cream teas. They also serve a lovely breakfast, local ales and a brilliant Sunday lunch.

Take binoculars to the bird hide observation hut. It has some information boards about the hut and the birds to help you.

Take the bus to Kingsbridge, it has a very interesting museum there and a lovely old fashioned cinema. **||**
