



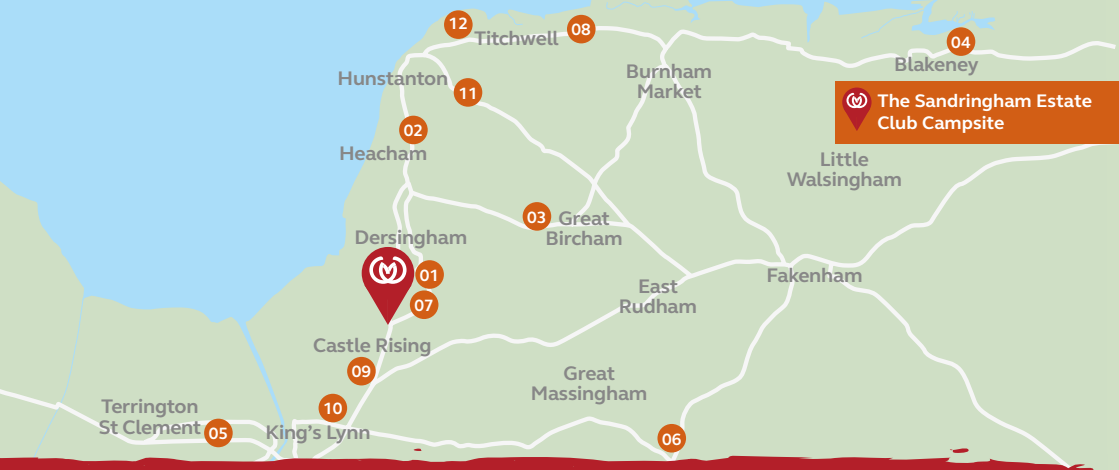

7 Local Walk

Walk through the woods to Sandringham House where there are two way marked Nature Trails and many woodland paths to explore.

10 Kings Lynn

An attractive and historic harbour town.

11 Hunstanton

A traditional seaside resort with sandy beaches, cliffs and Sea Life Centre.

12 Norfolk Coast AONB

A protected landscape of over 450 km² of coastal and agricultural land.

8 National Cycle Network

The nearest National Cycle Network route to this site is Dover to Shetland, Routes.

9 Local Routes

You can cycle in the royal park, or take the cycle track to Kings Lynn.





Visitor's top tips

|| Visit Wells-next-the-Sea. The town is picturesque and full of independent shops and the beach is beautiful.

The area is great for birdwatching, visit RSPB Snettisham and Titchwell. RSPB Titchwell is one of the few reserves you can take your dog to.

Cycle to King's Lynn on cycle routes and visit the 12th Century Castle Rising Castle on the way.

The Rhododendrons at Sandringham are lovely at the end of May/early June.

Walk along the Norfolk coastal path as far as you like, then use the local hopper bus to return to your car.

There's an excellent farm shop a couple of miles from the site if coming from the south.

If you enjoy plants and gardening we recommend Thaxters Garden Centre, well worth a visit with beautiful floral displays. **||**
